

Wolverine (Gulo gulo) Observation Quick Guide

Sighting

1) Record time, date, and location. If unable to photograph the animal, try to photograph tracks. Celebrate!

Tracks

- Search in a variety of locations for the clearest tracks. Look for where the animal has entered more sheltered areas away from direct sunlight, wind, further snowfall, or whatever may have obscured the tracks.
- 3) Photograph tracks, trail patterns, and other signs as outlined on the back of this guide. In your photo include a ruler, ski pole with tick marks, or any type of reference that indicates size down to the centimeter or inch.
